

RESEARCH STUDY TITLE:

Breaking Barriers to Genetic Testing Among Women of African Descent At-Risk for Inherited Breast Cancer

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Women of African descent who are 18 years or older
- Who previously completed the Breast Health Assessment (BHA) and were identified as high-risk for inherited breast cancer but did not complete genetic testing
- Are able to provide verbal consent to participate in the interview

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- An audio-recorded 1:1 virtual interview (approximately 1-hour)
- Flexible scheduling (Mon-Sun, 7AM-7PM)
- Receive a \$50 Visa gift card for your time and participation
- All information will be kept strictly confidential

WHY PARTICIPATE?

- Contribute to research that works to improve access to healthcare services (e.g., genetic testing, mammograms, breast MRIs and/or preventative surgery options etc.) for women of African descent at-risk for inherited breast cancer
- Provide insights to developing interventions that will increase awareness and access of genetic testing to empower women of African descent to take control of their health, advocate for personalized care, and contribute to closing the health disparities gap in breast cancer outcomes
